

Attached is a copy of iGatewayFile, the NC board-to-manager http file transfer program.

A copy of the one-shot http file transfer program is also on your NC board here at M2M. You can FTP it from the board at 66.162.98.169. The executable is in /home/m2minc The filename is iGatewayFile.

Launch the program by typing `iGatewayFile <dest IP address>` at the command line.

For example:

`iGatewayFile 66.162.98.173` for external NATs (from an external NC board to our test manager)  
or

`iGatewayFile 192.168.1.173` for using the NC board here at M2M and transferring files to our test manager.

This will transfer `msbin.dat`, `msgps.dat`, `mshum.dat`, `mstim.dat`, `mstmp.dat`, `msvlt.dat`, and `mswav.dat` from its local directory to a PHP page on one of our test managers. We are using these filenames rather than the 00E00x filenames to help in troubleshooting. If you want to switch to the 00E00x filename convention, please let me know.

When you have an RSA ready or data files ready, you can copy the iGatewayFile executable from your network controller here at M2M and put it on one of your local network controllers. The executable must be in the same directory as the data files. Then execute it as described above. This should serve for data transfer testing for the immediate future.
