Hi Colin,

Russell Siegelman from Kleiner Perkins again. Hope you are well.

I was sorry to have missed your recent visit to Kleiner Perkins because I was hoping to introduce to you one of our companies, Lilliputian Systems. Lilliputian is developing fuel cells to replace batteries in mobile devices such as cell phones and lap tops. These fuel cells will run on butane cartridges – similar to those in a cigarette lighter – and produce potentially 5-10 times the energy density of today's batteries, meaning longer talk/run time. They can be "hot swapped" so you never have to miss a phone call when your battery dies, or have to turn off your laptop when you run out of power. And of course they can power devices that are away from a power outlet indefinitely, so are ideal for international travel warriors! And of course they are better for the environment than LI-Ion batteries.

Building such a high energy fuel cell in such a small volume is quite an engineering feat. In fact most in the industry have said that it was impossible. But the company is making much progress and should have the first prototype running with net-power-out in November. Customers are now saying "Wow, you can do this". The first product will be a cell phone re-charger, which we expect will be available in mid 2007.

There are a couple of ways that you may be able to help.

1. The Armed Forces are very interested in micro-fuel cells due to the large amount of batteries that soldiers take into the battlefield. The company has had a DARPA program grant in the past, but we know there are many other opportunities. There are several ways to get this government money (I am not expert!) but I know one way the company is pursuing government funding is through the defense appropriations bill. The CEO, Ken Lazarus, would love to chat with you about this. I believe they have talked to Senator Kennedy's office (the company is located in MA) and have been told that if they can get a general to ask for this, then they will go to bat for it. Ken would love to strategize with you about who in the military he should approach.
2. The company, like all fuel cell companies, has to get approval for their products for airplane use. There is a proposal in front of the ICAO, the international group that sets regulations for what goes on airplanes that would include coverage of the Lilliputian product. The DOT recently came out in favor of including the Lilliputian class of products in this proposal which is a great first step. Ken would love to talk with you about the ICAO approval process where you may be able to help.

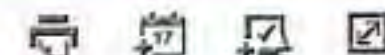

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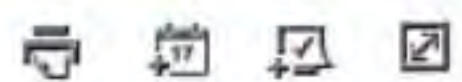

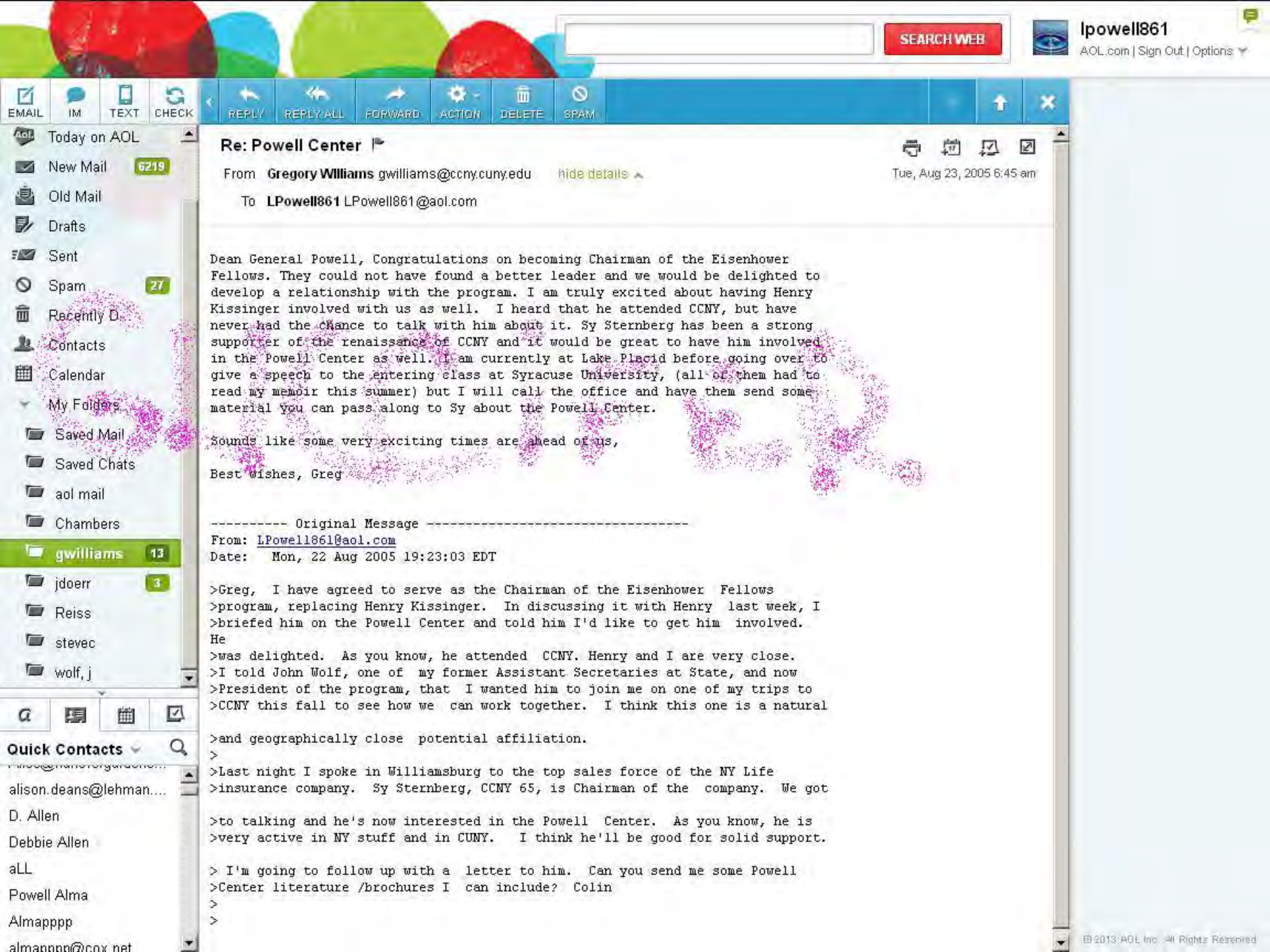

Sounds like some very exciting times are ahead of us,

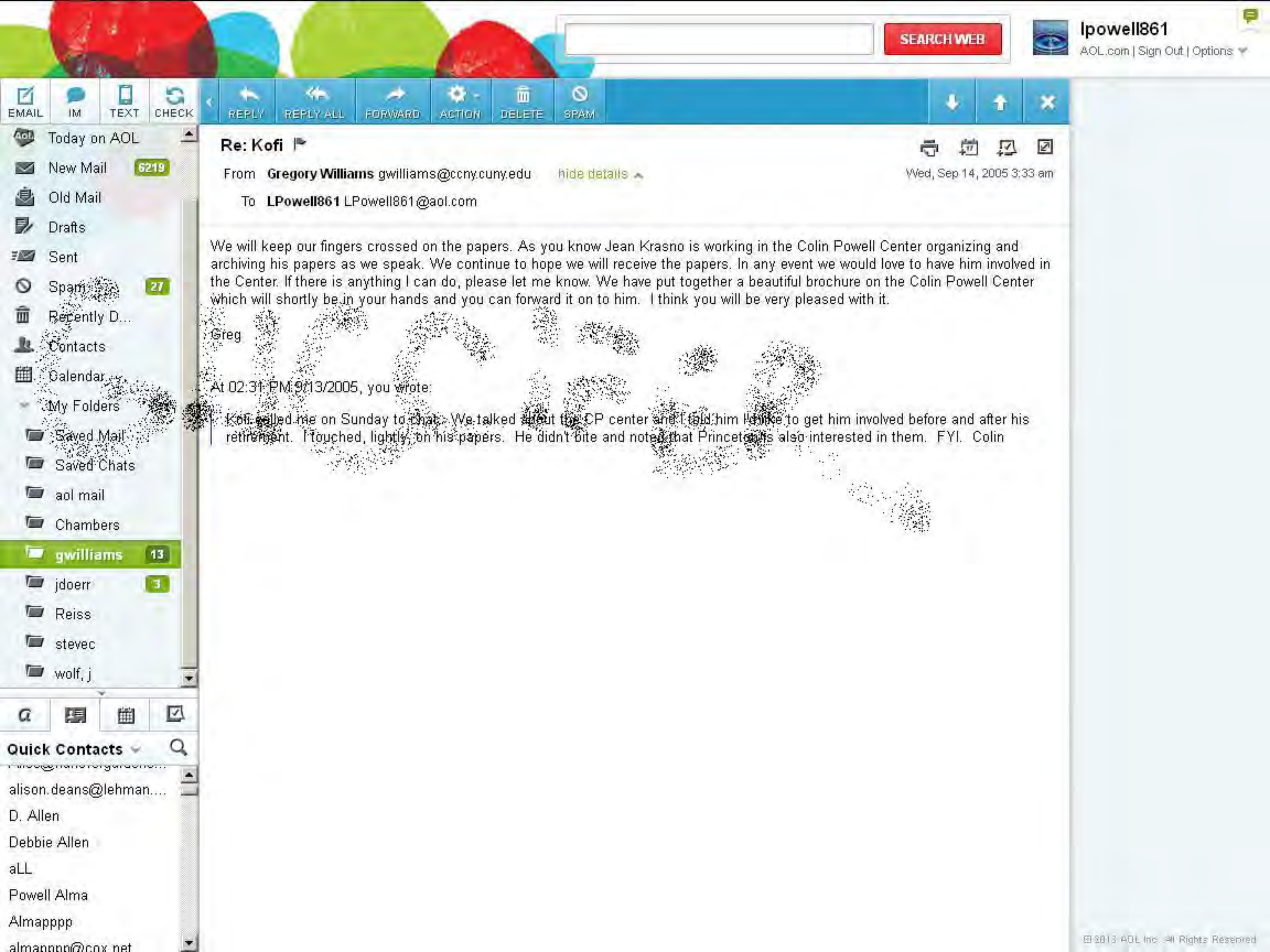

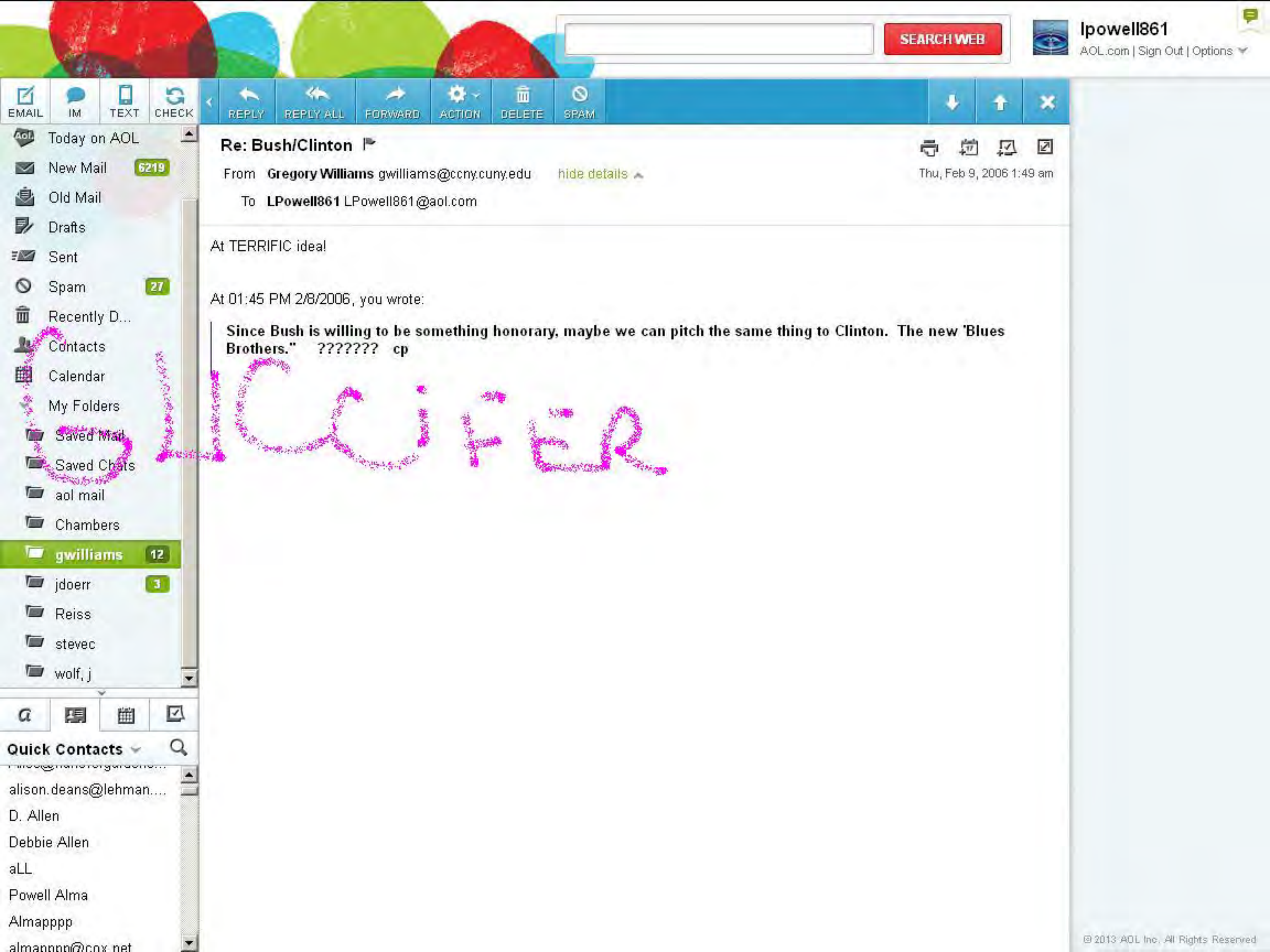

Gen Powell - I hope this note finds you well. Much has happened in the world since we last corresponded. Meanwhile, I'm at work on a new book, to be published by Simon & Schuster, about the group of officers and analysts who revived counterinsurgency doctrine and put it into practice, overhauling (to some extent, anyway) the culture and policies of the US military, especially the Army. Like a similar book I wrote 30 years ago, called *The Wizards of Armageddon* (also for S&S, in fact for the same editor, Alice Mayhew), about the whiz kids who invented nuclear strategy, it will trace the evolution and convergence of ideas, personalities and politics from within - seeing things from the protagonists' point of view - but, ultimately, from a critical perspective.

I suspect this is a topic of some agitation for you, as some of the COINdinistas (as they're sometimes called) see their ideas as an assault on "the Powell doctrine." (I should add that no *senior* officer has ever put it to me in those terms explicitly.)

I'd like to come talk with you about this project, and I'd like to discuss three things. First, I'd like to glean your historical wisdom on this topic. Unlike a lot of my protagonists, you've been around the bend with this a couple times (Vietnam as a soldier, El Salvador as a high-level adviser). Second, I think you've observed some of my characters as they climbed through the ranks. Third, there are certain aspects of the Obama presidency - especially his decisions on Afghanistan - that I'm hoping you could shed light on. I get the impression that, when he made his initial strategic decision (in March 2009), he didn't quite grasp that, in a COIN framework, it was very possible to set very limited objectives yet still get trapped into requiring very expansive resources, in terms of troops, time, and money.

In any case, I've been making frequent trips to DC to talk with sources, and I'm wondering if we could arrange a meeting during a visit in the near future. Or, if you'd rather meet during one of your trips to New York, I could do that, too. As it happens, my next trip is next Thursday, March 12. Any time then? If not, some other time, I hope.

Thanks for considering. I look forward to hearing from you.

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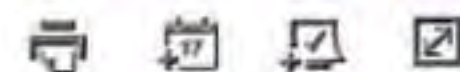
