 - e. Nearest relation: Ers. Lydia CAMERANO GERINO, Via Crovetto No. 3, Genoa, Italy.
 - f. Italian passport No. 36947-P/692, issued on 9 April 1946, valid for 1 year.
- 2. On 7 October 1946, Subject received a visa from the American Consulate, Genoa, Italy, valid for 1 year in the U.S.A.
- 3. Subject left Genoa on 26 October 1946 on the "Reuben Tipton", owned and operated by the Lykes Bros. The ship was a collier bound for Hampton Road, Va.
- 4. According to an informant of this office, Subject left for the U.S.A. and Mexico on a mission for either the PCI or the USSR Consulate, Milan, to perform espionage work concerning the atomic bomb.
- 5. A check with SCI(z), Genoa, failed to produce definite information that Subject is a Communist Party member or whether Subject is a collaborator of the FCI.
- 6. The above information has not been confirmed as yet.
