SUMMARY OF INFORMATION.-

SUBJECT: OZNA Suspects.

The following are generally suspected of being OZNA Informants or Agents:

1. Branko KOTZITCH di Zivojin and Leposava KOTZICH. He did not register in Milan, nor did he register at the Questura, as per current regulations emanating from the Italian Government. It has been ascertained by these Agents, however, that he is living in Milan most of the time and that he periodically reports to a commercial Agency named "INTRACO", located in Via Annunciata 23, Milan. This Office is frequented by Jugoslavs only and is directed by an Ing. Stanislao NASIC; it is generally suspected that this is nothing but an information Agency of the Government of Belgrade, covering its real activities under the guise of a commercial firm.

2. Cesare SALOM di Moise and Estera FINZI, born in Serajevo, the 23 July 1909, Yugoslav citizen, Jew, alleged businessman, formerly living in Milan, Piazza Santa Babila 5, since the 19th of July 1941, and now living in Via G. Tarra 9, Milan.

3. Elisabetta WEISS di Arturo and Etelka POPPER, born at ZABALY, Jugoslavia, 8 October 1908, housewife, married to Cesar SALOM and living with him. SALOM and WEISS lived at Santa MARIA Bagni (Lecce) and ROME, living in great luxury and spending great amounts of money. They are still living the same way here in Milan, although their financial possibilities should not allow them to lead such an expensive way of life. They are frequently in touch with salv elements, some of them identified as OZNA suspects.
