SUMMARY OF INFORMATION.-

SUBJECT: Suspected Yugoslav Agents.

From a source considered reliable this officer was informed that:

1) **HEIMZA MELAMED** is one of the most important Yugoslav (TITO) agents as well as personal observer for Marshal "TITO". He makes fortnightly trips to Yugoslavia (Milan-Trieste-Yugoslavia). Source reports that while in Milan MELAMED receives reports from other agents and Yugoslav communists which he carries back to Yugoslavia. Source also reports that before MELAMED left for Yugoslavia (several days ago) he carried information on the following subjects:

- a. Strength, distribution and communication systems of the Allied troops in Italy.
- b. Behavior of the Allies towards the Italians.
- c. Attitude of the Allies on the subject of Yugoslav immigration to Italy.
- d. Number of Yugoslavs in Italy.
- e. Italian sympathizers of "TITO" and the USSR

MELAMED has a brother, Rudolf MELAMED, who lives in Milan and frequents the La Scala Opera House Cafe'. It is believed that his business is a pro-forma. MELAMED is expected to return to Milan soon.

2) **VUKOVICH**(fun) is an ex-University student of the Institute of Technology who is a self-styled lieutenant of the Yugoslav Army. He lives in Milan at the corner of Via Plinio and Bruzi Sts. with another Yugoslav named PLAMENAC. VUKOVICH is strongly suspected of being an OZNA Agent. Three men of dark complexion and a tall, slender blonde woman visit him almost daily. They are believed to be agents of the Bulgarian Communist Party in liaison with OZNA Agents.
