1. Subject above presented himself to Capt. KIRKALDIE, "G" Control Unit 77, I.T. Milano, and requested a military uniform claiming he was an American citizen awaiting repatriation. Subject although claiming to have lived in Chicago for twenty-one years spoke bad English. Capt. KIRKALDIE became suspicious and contacted this officer to establish the identity of Subject.

- 2. This office interrogated Subject in length and finally obtained a voluntary confession from him.

- 4. Arrived in Goritzia, Italy in the fall of 1943 as a member of the above named medical unit. In November 1944, Subject deserted and joined the "Tito" partisans. Subject remained with the Jugs as a doctor, using the alia SCARDONA. In April he returned to Goritzia as a partisan, working in the ST. JUSTO hospital. After the German capitulation in Etzhy, Subject went to Milan and received employment with the Pontifical Commission until the end of August when he was hired by the 64th General Hospital in Milan. During this time he lived with his fiancee Antonzetta POZZI at Via Imbonate #25. Subject was unemployed from September 1945 when he left his employment until this date.

## RECOMMENDATION:

Subject is a prisoner of war and should be processed as such and sent to a separation center. Subject has no desire to return to Germany.
