SUBJECT : Yugoslav Army (TITO) Activity in VG.

SUMMARY OF INFORMATION

1. A confidential informant considered reliable reported to this Agent that at ERPELLE-COSINA (HERPELJE-KOSINA) eight artillery trains arrived. The majority of the personnel is of Serbian nationality. It is also reported that the non-commissioned officers are Russians.

2. Another report states that about 5000 soldiers have arrived in CAPODISTRIA. All these are new arrivals. It has been reported but not confirmed that 2000 of these new arrivals are specialists destined for the armored units in VG.
