SUMMARY OF INFORMATION.-

SUBJECT: Communist Agents' Activity.

1. On the morning of October 4, 1946, two propaganda Agents of the Communist Party ( a man and a woman) not better identified, were soliciting funds at the retail market that is held every day in Milan. The funds are for the Press and Propaganda branches of the PCI. The two agents were asking for funds in a determined and arrogant way. The comments of the people present were generally unfavorable.

2. It is not known if the two Agents were actually backed by the PCI. It is quite possible that the PCI is trying every possible way to obtain funds in order to alleviate its present difficult financial situation.
