SUBJECT: Suspected OZNA Informants.

SUMMARY OF INFORMATION:

A confidential informant considered reliable who has just returned from Trieste reported to this Agent that:

1. STEFANOVICH, Radmila, a young woman of about 22 years, living with the PIEMONTE family at Via Armando Diaz #7, and works for the British "police" (presumably FSS) is actually an informant of OZNA-Trieste.

2. The above named has a very close friend, POPOVICH, Desa, who is also in the employ of the OZNA and covers her activity by working for the Allied authorities (address and place of employment unknown).

3. LIUBO, Cicilliani, a resident of Spalato, who drives a BMW with Trieste registration #45665, is an informant of the OZNA and is strongly suspected of being a member of the kidnap group which forcefully abducts victims in Allied Venezia-Giulia on behalf of OZNA and carries them into Yugoslav occupied territory.

4. This same informant also reported that AMG movement passes can be easily obtained through the civilian employees of the AMG. Subject cited his own case, stating that he did not request the pass personally, but sent a third party to AMG with two packages of American cigarettes, who in turn contacted a civilian employee of AMG and after giving him the cigarettes, received the pass. The pass was signed for a certain Capt. J.H. DODRIGE, AMG, Trieste, 13 Corps.
