## MEMORANDUM FOR OFFICER IN CHARGE:

SUBJECT: Haimza MELAMED (alias ZIVOJIN MELAMED).

RE : Arrest of Subject

1. Persuant to instructions from Supervising Agent, CIG Milan Detachment, Zone 3, based on telephonic authority from Major Podesta, AFHQ, ND, this Agent arrested Subject.

- 2. Subject, mentioned in SOI, CIC Milan of 9 August 1946 and letter from G-2 AFHQ, Subject: Above Dated, 4 October 1946 was located by this Agent in Milan on 23 December 1946 and arrested on 2300 hours on 24 December 1946.
- 3. Subject is reported to be a special, personal courier of Marshal TITO, collecting general information submitted by Jugoslav Agents in Italy and carrying said information to Belgrade.
- 4. Sabject left Belgrade in the early part of December and went to Prague, Czechoslavakia. From there Subject entered Switzerland and stayed in Zurich. On 20 December 1946, Subject entered Italy by train at Iselle-Dowodossola. When arrested, Subject was headed for the Central Station in Milan to entrain for Rome. Subject was in the company of a brother Raffaele (RUDOLF) MELAMED and their aged mother, who lives at 13 Via Pozzi in Milan.
