SUMMARY OF INFORMATION.-

SUBJECT: Suspected OZNA Agents.

The following information has been received from a reliable confidential source, whose evaluation is A-2:

1. On 20 July 1946 two OZNA Agents arrived from Zagreb, Jugoslavia, in Trieste. They live in the home of an individual named LOZIC, Via Valdirivo 13, Trieste. Their official purpose is to perform a general survey of citizens of Zagreb who took refuge in Italy for political reasons.

2. One of the above is a Lieutenant and the other a Captain of OZNA. Their mission is to perform propaganda work among Crostians residing in Trieste. LOZIC, who is now looking for living quarters for the two Agents, stated that they plan to leave for Venice, Padova and Milan, and that at the moment of their arrival they had 250.000 lire and 30 British pounds. They speak fairly good Italian and German.

3. Particulars of the two Agents:

- a) TAMNJAK, (fnu): Height: 1.70- Stocky- Age 32- Flat nose-Oval face-Black eyes-bushy eyebrows-black moustache-dark complexion-jet black hair-right little finger has been amputated-baritoneal voice-wears an Omega watch.
- b) PAMER, (fnu) : Height: 1.80-Slim- Age: About 41; Regular nose- Brown hair- Ruddy complexion- Regular mouth- False teeth- elegantly dressed- Carries a 6x9 camera.
