SUBJECT: STEFANOVICH, Nedmila

TO : 5 SCI Unit, CEF.

1. Reference your request contained in letter dated 1 August 1946, Subject as above, requesting further information on Subject, this officer contacted informant with the following results.

2. Subject, according to informant, has lived with a certain SOLUNAC, Drago, (ex-lieutenant in the Royal Yugoslav Army) in Rome and for a while in Trieste. SOLUNAC confided to our informant that he would marry Subject as soon as Subject finished some important work she was doing and for which she was being well paid. Subject further stated to SOLUNAC that the nature of her work prevented her from continuing her relations with him at this time and that only after her obligations were fulfilled would she consent to marriage. SOLUNAC also inferred that Subject's employers were the Yugoslav (Tito) Reg. in Trieste. Informant also states that Subject is known as pro-Tito in Royal Yugoslav circles.

3. POPOVIC, Bess, lives with Subject. Her brother-in-law (nu) was a member of the German Gestapo in Lubjliana, but after the liberation became one of the leading communists in the same city. According to informant, POPOVIC's brother-in-law was a double Agent for Tito (having penetrated the German Gestapo) otherwise he would not be holding his present position in the Communist Party. POPOVIC is also marked as pro-Tito in Royal Yugoslav circles in Trieste.

4. LUISO, Cicilliani is known to many white Yugoslavs as a guide and line crosser. In November 1945 he is alleged to have aided the crossing of one man and two women from Yugoslavia into Italy. The man is only identified as VILKO and was a Yugoslav representing the Argentine Government at Zagreb. VILKO stated to our informant that LUISO crossed the frontier after presenting OSSA identification papers to Yugoslav frontier guards. One Giovanni VITURI, San Nicolo # 15, Trieste, also told our informant that LUISO by using his OSSA credentials effected the illegal crossing of his wife and child. Informant also stated that LUISO has a very bad reputation in white

Jugoslav circles and is feared by all as an OGBA gangster.

5. No other information could be obtained from informant at this time. In the event that this Office receives more information on Subject, your office will be notified immediately.
