Illegal crossing of the frontier

The above named Subjects crossed illegally from Spanish Morocco in the vicinity of Guezzane on 31 May 1944, and were apprehended by the Surete of that town.

1. LORENTO-PALINA, Manuel. Born on 31 October 1895 at Malaga, Spain. Subject is of Spanish nationality. Subject was in 1932 at Casablanca, French Morocco to Incarnation GARCIA-GONZALEZ. They have 5 children and their home is Tetouan Calle Maddadin, Spanish Morocco. Subject is classed as a chauffeur by profession.

2. GILVER-FRIAS, Joseph. Born in 1901 at Malaga, Spain. Subject is of Spanish nationality. Subject was married in 1932 in Tetouan to Dolores FRIAS BY whom he has 5 children. Subject's home is in Tetouan Calle B, No. 24.

The above named Subjects were sent to the S.S.T. at Souk el Arba for questioning where they declared that they left Spanish Morocco because they could not put up with the existing Spanish regime any longer. Nothing suspicious was found by S.S.T., Souk el Arba, and they were sent back to the "Brigade de Surete" of Guezzane, who in turn resitted the above named to Rabat for final disposition on 6 June 1944.

AGENTS' NOTES:

These Agents are of the opinion that there is a possibility that the above named could very easily be enemy agents. Since both Subjects have sizeable families and since no explanation has been advanced as to the present support of these families, it is very likely that the Subjects did not abandon their families only because of dissatisfaction with the present regime in Spain.

Since these Subjects are undoubtedly too old for military service, the only logical disposition of them would seem to be a labor battalion, or a concentration camp. It would be interesting to ascertain their eventual disposition.

The above named Subjects were sent to the B.S.T. at Souk el Arba for questioning where they declared that they left Spanish Morocco because they could not put up with the existing Spanish regime any longer. Nothing suspicious was found by B.S.T., Souk el Arba, and they were sent back to the "Brigade de Surete" of Ouezzane, who in turn remitted the above named to Rabat for final disposition on 6 June 1944.

These Agents are of the opinion that there is a possibility that the above named could very easily be enemy agents.
