MEMORANDUM FOR THE OFFICER IN CHARGE:

SUBJECT: Spanish Deserter

RE: FERNUL Y ALONSO, Seville

The above named Spanish deserter gave himself up to the "DAT" (anti-aircraft defence unit) at Boulay bou Selhem on 19 July 1944. Questioning by the "Gendarmerie Nationale" produced the following:

FERNUL Y ALONSO, Seville, Spanish, 21 years old, born on 16 July 1923 at Aviles, province of Asturias, Spain, son of FERNUL Armando, and of ALONSO Riecia. Subject is a beekeeper, attached to the 3rd Tercio, 8th Bandera, 26th Company of the Spanish Foreign Legion as a private.

On 18 July 1944, about 1800 hours, Subject deserted his unit at Larache and walked all night, following the coast. The next morning, 19 July 1944, Subject arrived at Boulay bou Selhem and gave himself up to the "DAT". As reason for deserting Subject stated that he was out of sympathy with the France regime and added that he would agree to join the French Foreign Legion for the duration of the war.

Subject was sent to the "Affaires Indigenes" bureau at Ouzans for further questioning.

AGENT'S NOTES:

Further information must be requested at DAT, Rabat. All deserters are now being taken to Ouzans for intensive questioning and the local bureaus do not receive the final report.

SUBJECT: Spanish Deserter

RE: FENJUL Y ALONSO, Emilio

The above named Spanish deserter gave himself up to the "DAT" (anti-aircraft defence unit) at Moulay bou Selham on 19 July 1944. Questioning by the "Gendarmerie Nationale" produced the following:

FENJUL Y ALONSO, Emilio, Spanish, 21 years old, born on 16 July 1922 at Aviles, province of Asturias, Spain, son of FENJUL Armando, and of ALONSO Nicola. Subject is a bachelor, attached to the 3rd Tercio, 8th Bandera, 35th Company of the Spanish Foreign Legion as a private.

On 18 July 1944, about 1300 hours, Subject deserted his unit at Larache and walked all night, following the coast. The next morning, 19 July 1944, Subject arrived at Moulay bou Selham and gave himself up to the "DAT". As reason for deserting Subject stated that he was out of sympathy with the Franco regime and added that he would agree to join the French Foreign Legion for the duration of the war.

Subject was sent to the "Affaires Indigenes" bureau at Ouezzane for further questioning.
