MEMORANDUM FOR THE OFFICER IN CHARGE:

SUBJECT: Presence of ex-Collaborationists in the
Frontier Zone at Moulay bou Selhem

RE: Dr. CHAUBET, Paul
CARRE, Jean Robert

On July 12 this Agent learned from a confidential informant of the arrival at Moulay bou Selhem of Dr. CHAUBET, his wife and their son. CHAUBET had in his possession an "ordre de mission" signed by the "Directeur des Services de Sante au Maroc" (name not determined) as "docteur de la plage" (doctor of the beach)

Before the arrival of the Americans in Morocco, Subject was a well known collaborationist from Fes. He and his wife have been heard to express anti-allied sentiments on numerous occasions, and his wife displayed photographs of Hitler and Petain to various people. Because of his anti-allied sentiments Subject was transferred to Midelt where he was kept under constant surveillance by French authorities.

On 13 July 1944, this Agent was informed by S.A. Woollett (whom this Agent had immediately ^{informed} upon the arrival of CHAUBET) that Subject had been joined by Jean Robert CARRE, director of the mines d'Auli near Midelt who is another well known collaborationist. (See memo, dated 9 May 1944, Subject, JONAS (FNU)).

This Agent then contacted Captain BOUSQUET, Chief BSM, Souk el Arba. BOUSQUET admitted that both Subjects were well known to him. After sending to Fes for their dossiers, and calling Rabat for instructions, he promised to do everything in his power to have Subjects removed from the frontier zone.

AGENT'S NOTES:

Although CHAUBET'S "ordre de mission" has been cancelled and he is being kept under surveillance, both he and CARRE are still at Moulay bou Selhem. The presence of these men so close to the frontier constitutes a potential menace to frontier security. This Agent suggests that both Subjects be forced to leave as soon as possible. According to another informant, CARRE IS THE MORE DANGEROUS MAN.
