MEMORANDUM FOR THE OFFICER IN CHARGE:

SUBJECT: Clandestine Crossing of the Frontier  
 RE: Alleged French Agent

From a confidential French police informant, these agents, to-day learned that on Sunday, 30 May 1944, M. Jean KALPES, a young man of some 40 odd years, provided with an "ordre de mission" No. 413 issued by the S.S.M., Rabat, was authorized to come to Souk el Arba with the intention of crossing into Spanish Morocco illegally.

While at dinner on that date, these agents learned that S.S.M. at Souk el Arba suborned his crossing after checking his papers, but without notifying these C.I.C. agents.

AGENTS' NOTES:

The old story of alleged agents crossing into Spanish Morocco from this zone is continuing and is creating increasing suspicion as to their regularity since several well-informed, local police officials, and prominent residents are of the opinion that these agents are political refugees.

It is imperative as previously mentioned many times that C.I.C. be notified concerning these passages.

While at dinner on that date, these Agents learned that B.S.N. at Souk el Arba authorized his crossing after checking his papers, but without notifying these C.I.C. Agents.
