Declaration governing the use of unsecured e-mail (without domain name)

Company name/name/first name (hereinafter the Client¹)

Domicile address: street/number, post code/town or city

When using unsecured e-mail, the Client agrees to the following terms and conditions for his **entire business relationship** (i.e. including all present and future banking relationships, objects and services) **with UBS AG (UBS)**:

1. Unsecured e-mail communication/authorization

The Client wishes to exchange certain information/data with UBS via unsecured e-mail despite the fact that UBS also offers more secure (e.g. including traditional) communication channels. Only the e-mail address(es) of the Client (and/or third parties) specified in the "E-mail address(es) of the Client (and/or third parties)" list may be used. Further special arrangements according to other agreements between the Client and UBS shall prevail. The Client acknowledges that any e-mail received by UBS shall be deemed to have been written by the person whose e-mail address appears as the sender's address in that e-mail, regardless of whether the e-mail was actually written and/or sent by that person or received by UBS with the correct content.

2. Risks

Since e-mails are generally sent across borders via open facilities which are easily accessible to third parties, the use of e-mail involves certain inherent risks including, in particular: (1) lack of confidentiality (e-mails and their attachments can be read and monitored without detection); (2) manipulation or falsification of the sender's address or content (e.g. changing the sender's address or information); (3) system outages and other transmission errors, which can cause e-mails and their attachments to be delayed, mutilated, misrouted or deleted; (4) occurrence of viruses, worms, etc. that may be spread undetected by third parties via e-mail and may cause considerable damage; (5) misuse resulting in damages caused by third parties intercepting e-mails.

3. Duty of care

UBS maintains computer and IT infrastructures that are operated in a manner customary within the industry. The Client undertakes to (1) consider the risks and take due care regarding e-mails received from UBS (if in any doubt, the Client should contact UBS by telephone); (2) reenter UBS's address when replying to e-mails (and not use reply buttons or links in e-mails); (3) take appropriate steps in the event that he detects or suspects any irregularities (e.g. the tampering with or falsifying of e-mails or e-mail addresses or if there is any doubt as to the origin of the e-mail), such as to immediately contact UBS and to delete the e-mails; (4) to update his own computer system and security software on a continuous basis (e.g. by installing recommended security patches, by observing customary

technical security measures, in particular the installation of firewalls and continually updated antivirus programs).

4. Exclusion of liability and warranty

E-mails are processed in the ordinary course of business and are **not dealt with on a priority basis**. In the event that the transmitted information is time critical, the Client must choose an alternative means of communication that enables timely processing. Either party may refuse to accept or process e-mails without expressly rejecting them or make further inquiries before processing. The Client is aware of and accepts the inherent risks of using e-mails, **in particular the risk that the banking relationship and confidential information relating thereto are disclosed to third parties**, and, as far as permitted by law, shall exempt UBS from any liability for losses or damages resulting from the use of unsecured e-mail. UBS excludes all warranty as to the correctness, integrity as well as the process of receiving and sending unsecured e-mails. The uninterrupted use of e-mails cannot be guaranteed due to technical, maintenance and security reasons. UBS therefore excludes all liability for losses or damages resulting from such interruptions or the overloading of IT systems.

5. Use of e-mail address

The Client authorizes UBS to use all agreed e-mail addresses within UBS for marketing purposes that relate to the existing account or business relationship; the Client shall have the option to request that UBS ceases to send such e-mails.

6. Amendments and termination

UBS reserves the right to amend these terms and conditions at any time. Any amendments will be communicated to the Client and shall be deemed accepted if not rejected in writing within one month after notification. Both parties shall be entitled to revoke this Declaration by written notice at any time.

Applicable law, place of performance, place of jurisdiction and place of debt enforcement

This Declaration shall be governed by and construed in accordance with Swiss law. The place of performance and exclusive place of jurisdiction for all disputes in connection with this Declaration shall be Geneva. This is also the place of debt enforcement for the Client if domiciled abroad (special domicile pursuant to Art. 50 para. 2 Swiss Federal Law on Debt Collection and Bankruptcy - SchKG). However, UBS reserves the right to take legal action against the Client at the Client's domicile.

The Undersigned¹ hereby declares that, as the holder (Client) respectively as the authorized agent of banking relationships with UBS AG (hereafter UBS), he wishes to use **UBS Online Services** within the scope of the banking relationship(s) included in the services of UBS. UBS shall enable the Authorized User (the Undersigned or user(s) authorized by him, hereinafter jointly referred to as "Authorized Users") to securely access a number of different UBS services via UBS Online Services, using certain communication channels. The available communication channels include electronic access via the **Internet** (incl. Internet via mobile end devices) or other **external networks** as well as the **phone**. Access shall only be granted once the Authorized User has authorized himself in relation to UBS using the personal means of authorization provided by UBS (e.g. smart card, PIN/password, agreement number). Thus the **identity of the Authorized User shall not be verified by checking signatures or identification documents** (cf. "Basic provisions for UBS Online Services").

(accounts/custody accounts, credits, mortgages, etc.) managed under the banking relationship(s) included in UBS Online Services **will be displayed automatically** in UBS Online Services.

Restrictions with regard to the products and contracts displayed or the services provided (e.g. no issuing of payment orders), special arrangements as well as access authorizations and changes thereto are to be governed by separate agreement ("Regulation of access authorization", "Authorization reference").

Certain services provided via UBS Online Services require the conclusion of an additional agreement. UBS may submit this to the Authorized User in electronic form once the latter has authorized himself via UBS Online Services. This shall also apply to amendments or additions to the present agreement. The services shall be activated on a case-by-case basis as soon as the Authorized User successfully applies for them, where necessary, and electronically accepts the additional special provisions. Following acceptance, the provisions shall become binding for the Authorized User and/or Client. Agreements concluded electronically shall be regarded as equivalent to agreements signed by hand. The provisions may be printed out and may be viewed in UBS Online Services. UBS is free to change its service offering at any time.

In addition to the other terms and conditions governing the banking relationship between the Undersigned respectively the Client and UBS, the **"Basic provisions for UBS Online Services"** including the separate **"Instructions"** supplied together with the personal means of authorization, any agreed **"Regulations of access authorization"** and/or **"Authorization references"** and additional special provisions governing individual services shall apply. The contents of the aforementioned documents form an integral part of this declaration. The Undersigned has received, taken note of and accepted these documents as binding. Following receipt of the Instructions, these shall be regarded as having been accepted with binding effect upon first use of the personal means of authorization.

This declaration/agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with Swiss law.

The place of performance as well as the exclusive place of jurisdiction for any disputes arising from or in connection with this agreement/declaration shall be the place of jurisdiction for the concerned banking relationship with UBS in Switzerland. This is also the place of enforcement for the Undersigned should he/she be domiciled abroad (special domicile in accordance with Art. 50 (2) SchKG).

UBS shall, however, be entitled to assert its rights at the domicile of the respective holder of the banking relationship(s) included in UBS Online Services.

Legal provisions

Upon signing the present "Regulation of Access Authorization", these provisions together with the "Declaration regarding the use of UBS Online Services", the "Basic provisions for UBS Online Services" including the separate "Instructions" as well as the special provisions for further optional services shall become contractually binding for all products and contracts managed under the aforementioned banking relationship. The Undersigned undertakes to comply fully with the provisions and to impose them upon the Authorized Users authorized by him/her. In addition, the Undersigned shall ensure that the Authorized User in question meets the requirements for the use of the designated means of authorization.



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The present "Regulation of Access Authorization" and the further provisions listed above are subject to Swiss law. The place of performance as well as the exclusive place of jurisdiction for any disputes arising from or in connection with this 'Regulation of Access Authorization' or said provisions shall be the place of jurisdiction for the concerned banking relationship with UBS in Switzerland. This is also the place of enforcement for the holder of a banking relationship should he be domiciled abroad (special domicile in accordance with Art. 50 (2) SchKG). UBS shall, however, be entitled to assert its rights at the domicile of the respective holder of the banking relationship(s) included in UBS Online Services resp. the service UBS e-banking.
